


FUNDS RAISED AND ACHIEVEMENT HIGHLIGHTS, 2018



IN 2018, AWARE'S ACHIEVEMENTS INCLUDED:

Justice for Sexual Assault Survivors

In 2018, our Sexual Assault Care Centre saw a 57% increase in cases over 2017.

In February, our recommendations to protect sexual assault victims were reflected in amendments to the Criminal Procedure Code and Evidence Act.

In October, we submitted recommendations to the Penal Code Review Committee, including:

- Repealing marital immunity for rape
- Expanding the definition of rape and sexual assault

Finally, in November 2018, we launched Aim For Zero (aimforzero.sg), a two-year campaign to end sexual violence in Singapore.

Rights and Assistance for Single Parents

We continued our campaign for single parents' rights with #asinglelove. In March, in line with our suggestions, the Ministry of National Development lifted:

- the debarment rule on purchase flats for divorced couples
- the time debarment on rental flats

In August, we opened the SHE Project, a shelter providing single mothers with stable housing and training from Daughters of Tomorrow.

Expanded Women's Care Centre services

In 2018, WCC saw 32% more helpline calls and 48% more counselling clients over 2017. We also launched Syariah law legal clinics, and expanded the helpline to four languages.

Research on Low-Income Mothers

In August, we published the report "Why are you not working?": Mothers explain challenges with work and care with a blockbuster panel event.

Launch of the Power Fund

This women's rights fund provides 9 up-and-coming civil society organisations with financial and capacity-building support.
